Ferry to Watsons Bay where takeaway Fish & Chips from "Doyle's on the Wharf" can be lunch. Then take a walk to South Head or around "The Gap" (for those less energetic) before heading back to Circular Quay and North Ryde arriving back at the Park around 4.30pm just in time for happy hour.
